IMPORTANT NOTES:

WARM Program-"Once again Christ Church is helping our neighboring churches with the WARM program. The location is Holy Angels Church Hall in Avenue for Sunday November 23 - Sunday November 30. During this time the most critical need is to serve as a monitor for a 4 hour slot. Each slot has 2 male and 2 female monitors - so no one is there on their own. January 2026 Vestry Election Discernment: What Makes a Good Vestry Member? – At our Annual Meeting on **January 18, 2025** we will elect up to three new Vestry members, each for a three year term, to conclude in January 2029.

What qualifies one to serve? – One must be a “giver of record” (usually done through an annual pledge), who is age 18 and above, not related to a staff member, and either Confirmed or Received into The Episcopal Church (or willing to be during the next opportunity).

What qualities make a good Vestry member? Being able to work collaboratively, regularly attend worship services and parish events, and have a prayer/spiritual life (we conduct business, but maintain our identity tother as “church”).

The newly elected members will join the rest of the Vestry for a **half day learning retreat on Saturday January 24^h** to engage with the Holy Spirit for the upcoming year.
