Old Business:

New Propane tanks were installed at the parish hall

- Received bill from Taylor Gas for filling the tanks, Taylor Gas will send corrected bill for gas in tanks.
- Vestry approved new blinds for parish hall, church office has paid the deposit and will schedule install once blinds are received.
- Deans painting has provided an estimate of \$800 for cost of paint (25 gallons of paint @ \$32 per gallon) to repaint the big room in the parish hall, will be presented to vestry on 5/10/23. If approved church office will schedule.
 - We will only pay for the paint that they use.
 - Gregg will provide Jenni company contact name and phone number
- Church sign discussion
 - Waiting on quote for painted sign w/ concrete base
 - Proposal to purchase “temporary sign”, hang in place of old sign, then move to back side of church (inside cemetery fence) once new sign is erected.
 - Will present both proposals to vestry at next vestry meeting
- Rectory chimney discussion
 - Donnie has the capability to repair the damper and will do so. Once that work is complete B&G committee recommends allowing fires to be burned in rectory fireplace.
 - Recommend annual cleaning of chimney next cleaning will need to happen spring/ fall 2024.
- Stained Glass window discussion
 - Presented quotes for outer protective coverings for stained glass windows and clear windows. Will present proposal along with cost to vestry for covering over stained glass and clear windows.
