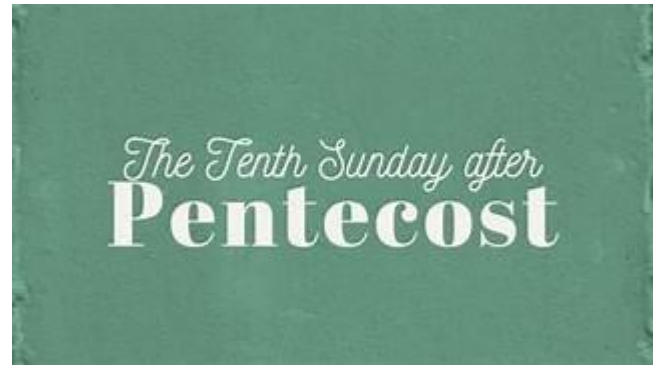

### **IMPORTANT NOTES:**

Summer Sunday Covenant- Beginning June 16th through August our Sunday services will be shorter, as a way of encouraging the congregation to include worship at 8am or 10am into your summer plans! Come dressed for the rest of your day, and enjoy a briefer worship experience. Our hymns will be shorter, we will not read the Epistle reading (the one after the Psalm) and Fr. Peter will offer truncated sermons - **Summer Sundays with Samuel** (our Old Testament readings this summer are 1 and 2 Samuel) which tell the story of David, the shepherd boy who becomes king.

The Bishop is coming - on Sunday September 8 - thus it is time for anyone who is baptized- teenage and above - to be Confirmed or (if already Confirmed in another denomination) Received. Either of these sacraments is what makes one a full-fledged Episcopalian. Fr. Peter will offer an individualized course of study based on Jennifer Gamber's books Your Faith Your Life (adults), My Faith My Life (teens). Please reach out to Fr. Peter at the church office so that he can help you prepare and we can get information needed for our records. The Vestry will soon determine if we will hold two services that Bishop/Confirmation Sunday or one, so stay tuned!
