1. Vestry Member Check In: Vestry members had time to check in with each other.
2. Call to Order: Brandon Frawley called the meeting to order at 6:32 p.m.
3. Prayer: The meeting opened with a prayer.
4. Vestry Minutes: The August 10, 2022 vestry minutes were accepted.
5. Treasurer's report – Brad Reeves: The Profit & Loss Budget Performance report was reviewed. After an intentional delay to make sure we were paying the correct Diocesan Asking, we didn't get back to it and now we are behind. Bob Donaldson discussed the 2023 budget, pledge campaign, probable shortfall in the future, and the need to take a hard look at expenses going forward. The Treasurer's report was accepted.
6. Junior Warden's Report – Brandon Frawley: From last B&G – update on handicap ramp, we are currently waiting on brick (which is being donated by the contractor). New cameras have been installed in the parish hall: one at the front door so that the administrator can see who is coming in and out, one pointed at the dumpster, and one in parish office. We are getting new lights in the choir loft and choir stairs. Church members are going to donate to fund that; we are currently waiting on the availability of the contractor. The Audio/visual system install started yesterday and will continue tomorrow, then we will have training on the system. We have received quotes in the past for cabinets in the back side pews of the church. Another quote came in today at a much lower dollar amount. Will gather more info and discuss later. The main church sign was accidentally knocked down, so we're looking to put one or two signs up, and that will be an expense.
7. Senior Warden's Report – From Keith Owens: We need a signup sheet for food/drinks for the bonfire on 10/22. Marie Ackerman is coming next week. There was a discussion on getting some food, a table and chairs, a temporary bed, etc. to the rectory. Call lists: we need to get back to calling the parishioners, especially now to make sure everyone knows that Fr. Peter will begin in November. Dottie volunteered to head that effort. A parish Wish List was brought up; things that parishioners may want to fund, if they were aware of the need and the desire to purchase. We could include that information in a newsletter.
8. New Business:
 - a. Dave Hudson, pumpkin carving: They used to do a pumpkin carving and chili/cornbread dinner at All Saints, and they always had a good turnout. He would like to have one this year, and it is tentatively planned for Friday October 28th. (**Update: date has since been moved to Saturday, October 29th.*)
 - b. Let's all think about a gift for Fr. Dan, to show our appreciation. A framed print of the church, or a donation towards a charity in his name? Lynn and Chip are having a 50th

- anniversary celebration at their house on October 30th from 1-4. Fr. Dan will attend, and Lynn would like to recognize him there.
- c. We had to cancel the fall dinner event because no one wanted to be in charge of the kitchen, but now Smitty (Ronald Smith) has said that he will take on that role.
 - d. Brad's Rotary Club is having a Flags for Heroes event, where flags are flown on the CSM campus. Brad will provide more information.
 - e. Action items:

 - ii. work on a community outreach committee,
 - iii. Dave is heading up the pumpkin event,
 - iv. items to the rectory this weekend - Lynn B., Susan and Brandon
