Advent Sunday Class- Beginning on Sunday December 3rd, at 11:30 a.m., Fr. Peter will offer a one-hour Advent Class up the hill from our Parish in the downstairs Vestry Room (or, if class size is smaller, his office). He will use the *Journeying the Way of Love*, offered through our Diocese. We will engage in three of the four sessions (4th Sunday of Advent is 12/24) as we await the coming of Christ by moving through the first two chapters of the Gospel of Luke. Luke's gospel provides a pattern for understanding how we can live the <u>Way of Love</u> as individuals, as families and friends, as a community, and out in the world. There is no need to sign up ahead of time, all are welcome.

<u>Blue Christmas Service - Saturday, December 16th at 3:00 p.m.</u> - This service is particularly for people for whom the holiday season is less than pleasant. Perhaps the death of a loved one keeps them from celebrating in the same spirit as everyone else. This short service, allows the gathered, to quietly and within their hearts, name that which brings them up short in the season. The result is that people are able to engage with the season better, having started in an authentic place.

<u>Staff Appreciation Gift</u> - In the spirit of the season, we want to offer an opportunity for you to thank our staff for their diligent work and service this year. If you would like to contribute to a financial gift that the Wardens will portion out to our staff members, merely write your check out to Christ Church with "Staff Gift" in the memo line. Our Administrator Jenni, and our Musician Marcus will receive the bulk of your generosity, with Fr. Peter receiving a smaller share, if any (at his request). These donations need to be received by the last service on December 17th.
