Acolytes! We are putting out the word that we would like to see if any of our young people (4th grade on up) would like to serve as an Acolyte. The Acolyte carries the cross at our services and assists the priest at the altar table. If you are interested and willing to serve about one service per month please reach out to Fr. Peter or parishioner Monty Wright. Fr. Peter will do training with any and all persons who are interested in possibly serving..

Lay Eucharistic Ministers (LEM) and Training - On Sunday, September 17th, following the 10am service, Fr. Peter is going to provide a LEM training/refresher, both for the current LEMs from each of our services, and for those who want to know more about the ministry. Mid-Week Services Beginning in September - In the fall we will go back to our mid-week 7pm services on Wednesday evenings. Most of those will be our usual prayer gathering, where people pray over the parish prayer list and any intentions that they bring with them. On the THIRD WEDNESDAY of every month, Fr. Peter will offer a Healing Service at 7pm. There we can pray together, along with the opportunity for you bring up quietly to Fr. Peter what healing you request for yourself or another, whether physical, emotional, or spiritual.

Last Call: Confirmation/Reception Into the Episcopal Church - On Saturday November 4th we will gather at the National Cathedral, along with members of our parish (and their friends and family) who wish to be Confirmed or Received into the Episcopal Church. Besides church attendance, and giving, Confirmation (or being Received if Confirmed in another denomination) is the way of formally becoming a member of the wider Episcopal Church. Please reach out to Fr. Peter by the end of August if you are interested.

Sunday August 27 "Sermon Time Hymn Sing" - at our final service of the month, Marcus, our organist, and the choir have agreed to lead the congregation in at least one verse of their favorite hymn.
