<u>Acolytes!</u> We are putting out the word that we would like to see if any of our young people (4<sup>th</sup> grade on up) would like to serve as an Acolyte. The Acolyte carries the cross at our services and assists the priest at the altar table. If you are interested and willing to serve about one service per month please reach out to Fr. **Lay Eucharistic Ministers (LEM) and Training** – On Sunday, September 17<sup>th</sup>, following the 10am service, Fr. <u>Mid-Week Services Beginning in September</u> – In the fall we will go back to our mid-week 7pm services on Wednesday evenings. Most of those will be our usual prayer gathering, where people pray over the parish prayer list and any intentions that they bring with them. On the THIRD WEDNESDAY of every month, Fr. Peter will offer a Healing Service at 7pm. There we can pray together, along with the opportunity for you bring up quietly to Fr. Peter what healing you request for yourself or another, whether physical, emotional, or spiritual.

**Last Call: Confirmation/Reception Into the Episcopal Church** – On Saturday November 4<sup>th</sup> we will gather at the National Cathedral, along with members of our parish (and their friends and family) who wish to be Confirmed or Received into the Episcopal Church.
